Before the flying competition, we all had a quiz to answer and all correct answers added to our score. It was very enjoyable and our flying skills were well tested.


I am not sure if the photo of PGL Tyre made Facebook (see left) but it does show you what happens when you over exert the brakes on landing on a bitumen airstrip.




We may need to make this a regular feature as most pilots did better at the flying than the questionnaire. Hopefully everyone found the questions interesting.


Thanks to Kate for organising the morning tea, a great spread of yummy treats contributed by members.


